## Billing Tips (Subject to Change, Check with Insurers)

### Commercial Insurers:

Preventive Services with USPSTF Recommendations Grade A or B or on the AAP Bright Futures™ Schedule should be covered by commercial insurers without a co-pay or deductible (mod. 33).

### MaineCare will:

- Reimburse for general developmental and autism screening using codes: 96110 (ASQ-3, PEDS, SWYC) (\$8.99); 96110 HI (MCHAT 1 or R) (\$8.99); 96111 HK (MCHAT 2 or F) (\$86.59). Reimburse for screening for Brief Emotional/Behavioral Assessment 96127 (\$3.37); broad psycho-social functioning 99420 HE (\$7.53); Maternal depression 99420 HD (\$7.53).
- Reimburse medical providers \$20 once every 6 months for an Oral Evaluation (D0145) for patients under 3 years of age and counseling with the primary caregiver.

- Reimburse medical providers \$12 twice in a calendar year for a fluoride varnish (D1206). A third application is possible with prior authorization.
- Reimburse for depression screening for 12-18 years 96127 (\$3.37).
- Reimburse for substance abuse screening using counseling codes (96160) (\$3.00).
- Reimburse for HPV vaccine for youth ages 19-26 years.
