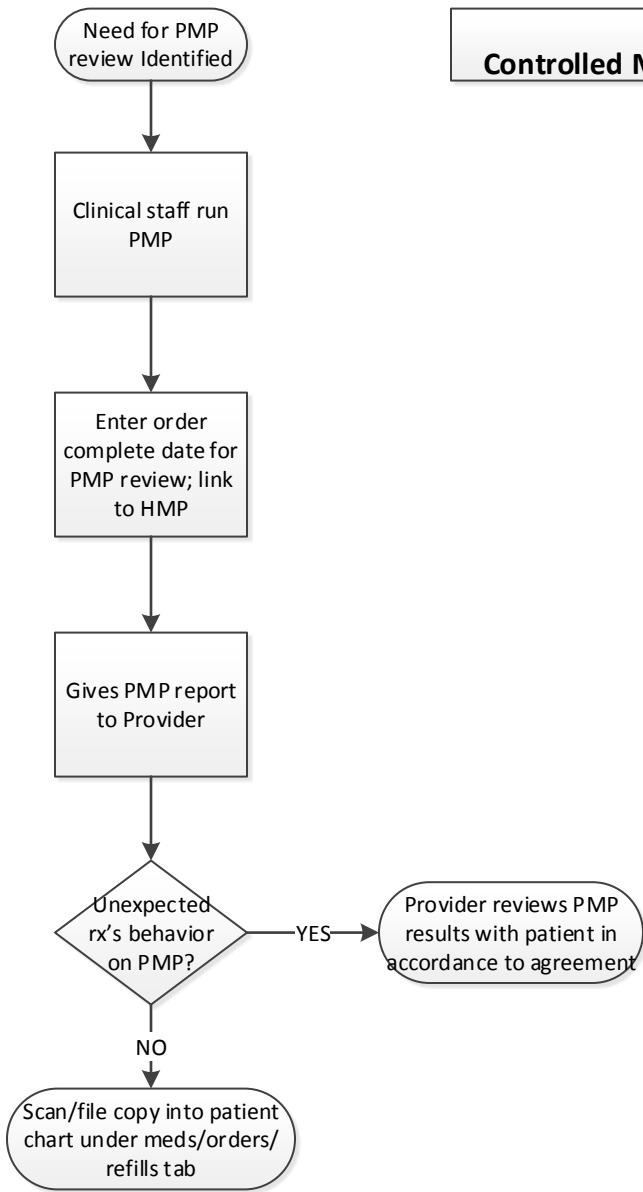


PMP Review Process
Controlled Medication Management Process 10/3/2014



- Reasons to run PMP:
- An Established pt starts a controlled medication
 - New Patients already on a controlled medication start seeing us
 - Any time there is a suspicion of diversion
 - When patients come in for urine drug screen (To stay on same schedule)
 - When patients sign annual contract (Stay on same schedule)
 - Any new patient/Adult 18+
 - Scan PMP into chart
 - Clinical staff runs PMP,
 - Provider reviews
 - HIM Scan/file under Meds/orders/refills

Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) and Diversion Alert Program (DAP) INFORMATION

All prescribers will register with the Maine Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) As of May 1, 2014, per L.D. 1840 22 M.R.S.7249(5), the PMP program will be working with the licensure boards to automatically enroll prescribers of controlled substances when they apply for or renew their professional license. The PMP database is accessible through HealthInfoNet, after registering at www.maine.gov/pmp.

A supplement to prescription data is alerts of diversion at www.diversionalert.org.

While the Maine Diversion Alert Program and the Maine Prescription Monitoring Program are both tools which aid prescribers and pharmacists in addressing prescription drug misuse, there are some significant differences between the two programs.
