Needs Assessment: Through QC's discussions with Maine clinicians who are providing medications for OUD as part of our Caring for ME and Northern New England Practice Transformation Network initiatives, we've identified significant variations in care, and frequent questions from clinicians about issues related to prescribing of these medications. These discussions identified a clear need for additional education about the topic, and a need for information about the recently-released SAMHSA TIP63 guidelines as the current national standards of care for providing medications for OUD.
